

Magazine Video Presentations

3 Minute Minimum → 5 Minute Maximum (Choose one of the ten articles from [this link](#)) ([Video Instructions](#))

After reading your article, you must record a video reporting back on the following things:

1. Title and date of the article.
2. Share the main point and summarize the article (this should be the longest part of your video).
3. Explain at least 4 facts from the article you feel are interesting.
4. State whether you thought it was a good or bad article and explain WHY.
5. In what way did the article relate to the information covered in class so far?
6. Come up with at least 1 question that you still have that was not answered by the article.

Keep these things in mind while recording to be successful (what I'm looking for):

- Meets all requirements listed above for what should be included in the presentation
- Presents information, findings, arguments and supporting evidence clearly, concisely, and logically; audience can easily follow the line of reasoning
- Organizes time well; no part of the presentation is too short or too long
- Keeps eye contact with audience/camera most of the time; only glances at notes or cards
- Uses natural gestures and movements
- Looks poised and confident
- Wears clothing appropriate for the occasion (no pj's)
- Speaks clearly; not too quickly or slowly
- Speaks loudly enough for everyone to hear; changes tone and pace to maintain interest
- Rarely uses filler words (ummm, uhh, ok)
- Uses correct and appropriate words for the task; doesn't rely on slang or unofficial terminology
