



All of the pictures above were taken by space probes. Space probes have changed what we know about our Solar System.

Your assignment is to write a small 1 page report about a space probe. Using the websites linked on MrHyatt.rocks, select a probe. Using the guidelines below, collect the required information about your probe and then write your report. Have fun learning about a space probe.



Your report must include the following:

- Title (example – Astonisher 1700 Visits the Planet Ulu)

- First paragraph – Identify the probe, when was it launched, how long it took to get there, how long it worked (if it’s still working, say so), etc.

- Second paragraph – What did it do once it got there. What experiments were done? How successful was it? What was some information that was sent back to Earth? If it is no longer working, why did it stop working?

- Third paragraph – Any other information, and conclusion.
 - Your paper must be neat and grammatically correct.
 - Include a photo of your space probe.
 - Include a photo that your space probe took (if it can take photos)

How long should your paper be? Long enough to complete the assignment. Ask yourself, “If someone doesn’t know about my space probe, would they know where it went, how long it worked, and what it accomplished?” If you can’t say “Yes,” then your report is too short! If it needs to be more than 3 paragraphs, it should be.
